Tufts Global Research Program (GRAP) - <https://global.tufts.edu/GRAP-students> provides the opportunity for Tufts students to work with Tufts faculty members on international research and impact projects for a minimum of eight weeks during the summer.

IGL Initiative at Tisch - is an incubator of innovative ways to educate learners at all levels to understand and engage with difficult global issues. UCETAM English Language Assistant program <https://colegiosbilinguesscooperativos.com/auxiliares-conversacion/english-language-assistant/> Program offers 18 or 26 hour English Language Assistant positions at UCETAM-affiliated schools within the Community of Madrid. Integrated within the English Language Assistant's schedule is one hour exclusively for planning & organization time.

Teaching Assistant Program in France (TAPIF) www.tapif.org Offers you the opportunity to work in France for 7 months, teaching English to French students of all ages. Each year, about 1,500 American citizens and permanent residents teach in public schools across all regions of metropolitan France and in the overseas departments of France such as French Guiana, Guadeloupe, Martinique and Réunion.

The Wildlife Research and Conservation program <https://www.wildlife-research.com/get-involved.html> gives wildlife enthusiasts, volunteers, students, scientists and interns of all ages and backgrounds an opportunity to get involved in conservation, research and wildlife management. Participants spend five days per week assisting in various capacities of research and wildlife conservation. Evenings and weekends open which allows the chance to explore the beautiful coastal town of Hartenbos, South Africa.

Princeton in Asia (PiA) Fellowship <https://piaweb.princeton.edu/for-applicants> is an independent non-profit organization affiliated with Princeton University. Founded by Princeton students in 1898, the program aims to contribute to building a world where individuals share a mutual appreciation and respect for the diversity of cultures and perspectives. The fellowship program offers Fellows a change in perspective, a job that matters and a community for life

Meddeas Educator Training Placements and Language Assistant program

Teach English, German, or French as a Language Assistant and develop your skills in a Spanish private school. Language assistants are covered by a monthly stipend and there are no fees to participate.

North American Language and Culture Assistants Program NALCAP

Short term contracts and/or alternative starting dates are

unfortunately not available. Depending on the assigned region, NALCAP recipients receive a monthly stipend of 800 to 1000 euros and medical insurance from either the Ministry of Education of Spain or the regional governments of Spain.

Argahozo Shalom Youth Village <https://www.asyv.org/become-a-fellow> This organization has employed Tufts' students in the role of a fellow. Every year, a group of talented individuals from around the world joins the Village to provide specialized skill sets and serve as 'cousins' to ASYV's students.
